Misión Mazahua Advisory Board Meeting

Pastor Dan Vellinga opened the April 17, 2004 meeting with a word of prayer.

Dave McCoy moved to accept the minutes from the February 21, 2003 meeting. Janet Johnston seconded. Motion carried.

Dave McCoy reported that at the last meeting he was mistaken on what the cost would be for a web sight. The cost is more like \$100 a year. Amy said that the search committee had an e-mail thru the church maybe we can go thru the church for the web sight. If the advisory board had any expenses, Plain has always covered the costs. Dave McCoy will check into going thru the church, if we can't, then we will hold off on any decision until June.

The meeting was turned over to Pastor Dave Hawk. He said that June 12 is a good date for the next meeting, Lisa and Norberto will be able to attend. Rebecca's wedding is June 26th.

Dave Hawk gave a very detailed treasurer's report which can be found online.

The regular monthly income thru the advisory board has been getting smaller each month. Regular donations come from the same people and churches.

Barry Milliron moved to accept the treasurer's report and Dave McCoy seconded. Motion carried.

Pastor Dave passed out a list of what he sees as his job description will be as the North American Representative for Misión Mazahua. Pastor Dave stated that the mission needs tons of money and he needs a salary. We need to expand our partnership for donors and increase prayer support. He would like to start a 20 club. We would look for 500 donors to give \$20 a month and pray for the mission. Of the \$20, ten would go to the mission and ten will go to Pastor Dave for his support. Each of the 500 donors will receive a monthly e-mail which will include one praise report, one prayer report and one ministry update. This will expand the donor pool and prayer base, raise more for the mission and give Pastor Dave a salary.

There was a lot of discussion. Pastor Dave feels that God has called him to this new position. Pastor Dan wants to be sure that everything is crystal clear as to what Dave is doing – this is a new position for MMAB. That everyone knows that Lisa and Norberto are in favor of this position. Lisa and Norberto will be going east for deposition and it was suggested that Pastor Dave accompany them as an introduction for his fund raising.

The question was asked as to whom Pastor Dave would be accountable to. He would be accountable to Misión Mazahua Advisory Board and Misión Mazahua. The Mexican Civil Association has offered Pastor Dave an ex-officio membership (non-voting).

Pastor Dave feels we need to have the books audited.

Lisa and Norberto and Pastor Dave have begun a process where they are pairing up intercessors with one person who they want to see come to Christ. They will be asked to pray for only one person. Need to have the people working for the mission to be Christians.

Pastor Dave's new position as the North American Representative for Misión Mazahua was approved by consensus, knowing that the specifics will have to be worked out. The MMAB supports Pastor Dave Hawk in this position.

Pastor Dave Hawk closed the meeting in prayer.
