Misión Mazahua Advisory Board Meeting

Pastor Dan Vellinga called the June 12, 2004 meeting to order and Dave McCoy opened in prayer.

Janet Johnston moved to accept the April 17, 2004 minutes with one spelling correction. Bob Siler seconded. Motion carried.

Pastor Dave Hawk gave his treasurer's report for April and May and since June will be the end of the quarter he reported that when he does the quarterly report at the end of June it will be put on the internet. When Pastor Dave sends money down to Lisa & Norberto he tries to coordinate with what is happening at the hacienda and that way he can be sure there is money there when they need it. Sun City Congregational Church, Sun City Arizona received a van from a member of their church and they gave the van to the mission. Dave McCoy moved to accept the treasurer's report. June Swaney seconded and motion carried.

Norberto said that he needs the profit from sales of merchandise to pay expenses while in the U.S. Groups or churches should see the sales of merchandise as a ministry. They need someone to organize and sell the smocked dresses. There is a need to coordinate where Lisa & Norberto will be with orders so they can have the merchandise with them.

MMAB welcomes the service of Pastor David Hawk as the North American Representative of Misión Mazahua, and agrees to support his work in a fashion similar to that which has been observed with Lisa and Norberto. In particular, MMAB agrees to receive donations in support of Pastor Hawk's ministry with Mazahua Mission. It is understood as we begin that *only* those donations designated for Pastor Hawk's support (either by immediate notice or by prior declaration of such an intention) will be allocated to him; there will be no subsidy for his stipend from any other fund, including the MMAB general fund.

Dave McCoy moved to accept this wording for the formal motion, and June Swaney seconded. Motion carried.

Dave McCoy made the motion that In the event that the treasurer and the North American Representative is the same person then the MMAB will have in place measures that assure proper accountability. Bob Siler seconded and motion carried.

Norberto went over the restructuring and reorganization of the Mexican Civil board.

Misión Mazahua's wish list: Power Point Projector; a Sound System; fast Lap-top computer; reliable Vehicle for Pastor Dave; surgery for Jovita (at least \$3,000) and a Heavy Duty Roto-tiller.

Norberto reported that the influence among non-believers has mushroomed. They are in many villages that they have never been in before. There are 450 Mazahua in Yonkers, N.Y. Norberto wants all that they do to be permeated with Jesus Christ.

The next MMAB meeting date will be October 16, 2004 at Plain Congregational Church in Bowling Green, Ohio at 10:00am. If you are able, you are welcome to come and attend.

Pastor Dan moved to adjourn and Barry Milliron closed in prayer.
