

**Misión Mazahua Advisory Board Meeting
Feb. 25, 2006**

Lisa started the meeting out with a devotion. Dave McCoy opened in prayer.

MINUTES: June Sweeny moved to approve the November 12, 2005 minutes. Jeanne Vellinga seconded and motion carried.

TREASURER: Pastor Dave Hawk presented the 2005 annual treasurer's report. There is a new line under category #1. It is called National Missionary Loan. Under disbursements is the Loan pay back line also under category #1. This loan was received from the NACCC Missionary Society to offset a major financial deficit last December, and is being paid back on an agreed upon schedule. Money is now being set aside in the General Fund so that it will be available next December when, under Mexican law, they have to pay double salaries to all employees. There will be two new categories in 2006 - #38 North American Rep. expenses and #70 Dave Hawk support (like Lisa & Norberto's support) Watch category #17, it will be expanded as there are a number of teams going down to the hacienda. This will be for their team participation fees. Motion to accept the report carried.

Pastor Dan welcomed Lisa to the meeting today.

More cisterns are being made; a Massachusetts group built 2 cisterns at the hacienda.

Lety and Judith came to the U.S for one week. They visited Chicago and Milwaukee.

The Plaza Comunitaria is finally up and running. Elizabeth will be in charge.

There are two new micro enterprises going on. 1.) Mole is a traditional sauce. 2.) A specially mixed granola that includes amaranth, a native grain. One half ton of mole and 880 lbs. of amaranth are being packaged and sold to a restaurant chain monthly, if orders hold steady.

Norberto is working with pastoral training Seven to thirty leaders meet monthly to study Scripture, pray together and consider ways to strengthen believers and churches in the region.

Samuel & Abel are reviewing the "Jesus Film". The Mission expects to support their efforts to show the film and do evangelistic follow up throughout Mazahua country.

Molino center for International Teams needs a lot or work. Lisa calls it “Hope Center”.

The bus has not gone down yet. It should start down to Mexico a week from Tuesday. More ceramics and stained glass needs to be sold. They have an overstock of inventory. Lisa says that they need to sell! Lisa has given them ideas for selling. The people involved with the ceramics and stained glass need to sell enough to pay for expenses to keep things going.

Lisa said that 2 years ago Pastor Dave Hawk came on board with the mission as the North American Rep. and has not received any support until January. Please pray about this situation. Lisa and Norberto have raised the participation fees \$5 per person per night for teams, and those funds will be used to help support Dave. Lisa says that still is not enough. There was a discussion on how to get support for Dave Hawk. It was moved that the Advisory Board is to send a cover letter with a letter that Lisa and Norberto write. Motion carried with one nay.

Pastor Dan closed in prayer.

Next meeting will be June 10th at 10:00am. There will be a pot luck lunch following.
