

Here is a listing of specific Program Support Funds maintained by the Mission Mazahua Advisory Board. As much as possible, we will honor the preferences expressed by our donors, subject to the requirements of the current ministry mix at the Mission. That mix is a growing, dynamic response to opportunities God is opening to us. Occasionally we may need to modify the application of resources received. As far as possible, we will let you know if we find it necessary to redirect your donation. Your understanding and flexibility are appreciated.

- 02 Excelencias Mazahua (equipment, supplies, utilities, stipends to support crafts production)
- 04 Discipleship & Leadership Training (working with pastors, village leaders and others)
- 05 Scholarships (for Jr. & Sr. High, college, language school, special training needs, books)
- 10 Las Rosas (purchase, maintenance, renovation and operation of the facility)
- 13 Special Friends (programs for the handicapped; a large part supports the annual SF Camp)
- 14 Sewing Projects (training, fabric & supplies as needed, sewing machine repairs, etc.)
- 16 Solar Stove Project (materials, production, distribution, training & promotion)
- 17 Mission Team (room, board, travel, special activities)(please identify specific item covered)
- 25 Self Sustaining Enterprises (seed funds for training people and establishing microenterprises)
- 27 Support for Individuals (please tell us which staff person or Mission friend you're supporting)
- 30 Mission Mazahua Advisory Board operations (office supplies, postage, web costs, etc.)
- 31 Village Improvement Projects (cisterns, water projects, school improvements and others)
- 35 Cortes Retirement Fund (investment account to help when they pass on Mission leadership)
- 50 Sale of Consignments received from Lisa or Norberto Cortes (not tax deductible)
- 51 Sale of Products received from Excelencias Mazahua directly (not tax deductible)
- 61 Vehicles (purchase, major overhauls)(routine maintenance included in General Fund)
- 62 Agricultural Projects (equipment, facilities, personnel for alternative crop trials & promotion)

As new ministry opportunities arise, new Funds will be opened. For example, if we begin new Schooling Projects, we will open a new Program Support Fund to provide for the people and the program costs within this field. We will open new Funds in response to your proposals if they are consistent with Mission goals. More detail about each Fund is available upon request.

As specific projects are identified, particular accounts will be opened within the Program Support Funds. For example, there is a water project under way in Calvario del Carmen. Gifts directed to that project will go into their village account within Fund #31, "Village Improvement Projects". In similar fashion, when a student goes to college, resources given to support her studies will go into her specific student account within fund #05, "Scholarships".
